- The arrangements of the show shall be in the hands of the directors, committee
  and sub-committee. All persons entering the show premises shall be subject to
  the directions of the Stewards and Secretary.
- Every exhibit must be bona-fide property of the exhibitor in whose name it is entered.
- 3. No entry shall be received unless accompanied with the specific entry fees and the organisers reserve the right to return any entry without incurring any liability.
- 4. The organisers shall not be responsible for any claim for compensation or otherwise, in regard to the holding of or for anything arising out of or connected with the show. While every reasonable care will be exercised, the organisers will not be responsible for any accident, loss or damage, to any exhibit, Exhibitor, or Spectator from any cause whatever occurring at, or in transit to or from the Show.
- judges shall have the power to award 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> prizes according to the merits
  of the exhibit, or to withhold any or all of the prizes in any class for the want of
  merit.
- 6. Objections or appeals shall be considered by the organisers if lodged with the secretary, together with a €20 fee on the day the exhibit is judged.
- 7. No exhibit must be removed before 5.30pm on the day of the show.
- 8. Definition of an amateur: An amateur shall be understood to be one who does not engage professionally, or in the retail or wholesale trade, in relation to the article or produce covered by any class in this schedule.
- 9. The Irish Shows Association Levy of 5% will be deducted from all prize money in the relevant sections: Horses, Ponies, Donkeys, Cattle and Sheep.
- 10. Vehicles and trailers are parked at owner's risk.
- 11. Where a dispute arises, the matter will be dealt with in accordance with the ISA disciplinary procedures as appropriate.
